The radiographs have to be permanently marked with the name of the horse, date and place radiographed and with leg markings.

Radiographs shall be taken from the stallion with following projections

- All fetlock and digital joints lateromedial projection; both sesamoid bones and tip of the distal phalanx shall be visible.
- Hocks oblique projections (DLPM and DMPL); top of the calcaneus and top of the metatarsal bone shall be visible.
- Stifle joints lateromedial and dorsopalmar projection; the patella shall be visible (LM; DP)
